All schools in Hong Kong fully resume face-to-face classes

February 8, 2021

Dear Parents :

The resumption of face-to-face classes for all Schools after the Lunar New Year holidays was announced by the Education Bureau on February 5, 2021. From February 23 to March 5, 2021, school will arrange two or three days of face-to-face classes at all grades. School will apply for all students attending face-to-face classes on March 8, 2021 from Education Bureau. However, for the health and safety of the children, please arrange your child's return to school according to time.

- On days when face-to-face teaching is not possible, the school will use teaching videos, homework, teaching aids and graphics recorded by the teacher so that children can learn at home.

(B) Invite parents to cooperate with schools to implement epidemic prevention measures :

1. Preparation before leaving home

- a. Detect the children's heat before school and record the temperature on the temperature book.
- b. Change clean school uniforms for children every day

- c. Prepare 2 masks for children, put them in a clean and compact bag and bring them to school for later use. School will provide the extra if it is not enough.
 - d. Use 1:99 diluted household bleach to wipe schoolbags (the schoolbags cannot be buckled with for dolls), shoes, etc., wait for 15-30 minutes, rinse with water and wipe dry.
2. Arrive at our campus
 - a. Staff, children, parents and helpers who arrive on our campus must wear masks and take their body temperature
 - b. Parents or helpers are only suitable to reach outside the gate, from the inner gate only children are allowed to enter
 - c. Before children enter the school, the staff will spray them with disinfectant to clean their hands and check their temperature.
 - d. Before children enter the classroom, they will step on the disinfected carpet and wash their hands.
 3. Children fully resume face-to-face classes
 - a. Arrange the children into group A and B in batches to go to and leave school
 - b. Use the school space as much as possible, keep the children at a certain distance, and avoid letting them sit close
 - c. Children use the restrooms in batches at different times. Teachers, school workers must provide assistance and help
 - d. The teacher will make full use of the classroom space, arrange the children in batches and keep their distance. Children can bring a small amount of water back to school to drink, and refreshments will be distributed to the home to enjoy
 - e. For safety reasons, physical education classes and group activities will be temporarily cancelled. Classes are mainly personal activities, avoid gatherings and keep distance
 - f. Prevent children from sharing facilities, equipment and objects.
 4. Health measures in schools
 - a. During the Lunar New Year holiday, school items were thoroughly cleaned and disinfected, and school fans and air-conditioning dust collectors were cleaned
 - b. According to the guidance of the Health Protection Center, the school environment, equipment and supplies were cleaned and disinfected
 - c. All toilets in the school are equipped with hand sanitizer, toilet paper and trash can with lid
 - d. All classrooms in the school are equipped with anti-epidemic supplies, such as disinfection/alcohol hand sanitizer, disinfecting wet wipes, tissues and masks.
 - e. Before and after school every day, the school environment, equipment and supplies will be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected
 - f. Open the classroom windows and use fans and exhaust fans to increase indoor air circulation
 - g. If air conditioning is used, it will ensure that there is enough fresh air to provide
 - h. Children are not allowed to share goods for the time being
 - i. On February 20, 2021, the school has sprayed permeable disinfectant paint throughout the school.
 - j. If we find that the child is sick, we will immediately contact the parents to take him home to rest
 5. Health measures in school bus
 - a. Ensure school buses are clean and hygienic
 - b. Keep the air in the carriage in good condition
 - c. Drivers, nannies and children should wear masks before boarding
 - d. We will try our best to use the car space to let the children sit separately
 - e. Strengthen the cleaning times of school bus

Note : 1. The above arrangements refer to the guidelines of the Education Bureau and the Centre for Health Protection and will continue to be implemented
 2. Parents are requested to read the latest guide from the Education Bureau before continuing the class.

6. If parents are worried about fully resume face-to-face classes, they can consider leaving their children at home, and the school will flexibly handle student leave matters.

The school arrangements will be updated according to the latest news announced by the Education Bureau. Parents are kindly requested to pay attention to the announcements on the school website and the updates of online learning materials.
