"Compulsory Testing of the Whole School and the Stop of Face-to-face Teaching"

5th May, 2021

Dear Parents :

Today, several students in K1 class and K2 class took leave for upper respiratory tract infections (including runny nose and cough). As flu symptoms and upper respiratory tract infection symptoms are similar to the 2019 coronavirus, according to the instructions of the Centre for Health Protection, flu symptoms and upper respiratory tract infections of schools will be included in the mandatory testing announcement to rule out the possibility of contracting the new coronavirus. The school must suspend classes for five days for cleaning. All students and staff are required to undergo compulsory testing and have a negative test result before they can return to school after classes are resumed. The government will add this school to the mandatory testing list later today.

Details of the suspension are as follows:

1. Suspension of classes for five days (from 6th May (Thursday) to 10th May (Monday))
2. Receive saliva bottles or stool sample bottles for N1 to K3
 - The school has received a sufficient number of stool sample bottles (N1) and saliva bottles (K1 to K3) from the Department of Health for use in each classes. Parents please come to school on 6th May (Thursday) to collect the saliva bottle or stool sample bottle and homework according to the following time chart. Please hand in the saliva bottle or stool sample bottle to the testing center

CLASS	TIME
K3	10:30 a.m. to 11 a.m.
K2	11 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
K1 and N1	11:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon

3. Parents keep the message in the student test report.
4. Teachers and students can return to school on their own if the test result is negative on 11th May(Tuesday).
